At Doggie Daycare, your pet will not be crated for long hours, but will enjoy supervised playtime with other pets and our friendly staff.

Enclosed, you will find information and forms you need to register your pet for our daycare services. There is a **\$20 non-refundable, non-transferable, application processing fee** for each pet. Each dog is evaluated on an individual basis for socialization, temperament, and compatibility with our playgroup.

*** There is no guarantee of acceptance into our program.***

To enroll, please review all requirements and policies carefully, then simply fill out the attached forms, obtain your veterinary health certification and return them to us along with the \$20 (plus tax-- \$21.27) fee which can be paid online at https://petdegreedogtraining.com/product/doggie-daycare-interview/

How Much & How It Works

Daycare day rate: \$35 per day Drop In (Please reserve space in advance to avoid wait list)

\$20 per Half-Day Drop In Morning 7 AM - 1 PM \$20 per Half-Day Drop In Afternoon 12 PM - 5:30 PM

Bronze Package: \$264 for 8 visits during one month **Silver Package:** \$384 for 12 visits during one month **Gold Package:** \$496 for 16 visits during one month

Half Day Package: \$144 for 8 visits per month

*Additional days in same month with a package are billed at the package rate per day

*Dates for package required at time of purchase

Please note: Packages do not carry over! Any package days must be used in the calendar month. We do not credit for missed days. We do not bill. Medical makeup must occur within 2 weeks andmust have a vet diagnosis. Any reservations cancelled without 24 hours notice will be charged full day fees.

Hours: 7 AM - 5:30 PM, Tues. - Fri. | Morning/Full Day Drop Off is between 7 - 9 AM

Late arrivals will be asked to come in for afternoon drop off

Half-Day Drop Off or Pick Up is between 12 - 1 PM

Pick up anytime before 1 PM is a half day charge, anytime after will result in a full day charge Holidays we are closed: New Years Day, Easter, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas We may experience occasionaly closings for snow storms - when in doubt, please call ahead!

Late Fees: \$5 per 15 minutes past 5:30 pick up time. When daycare ends, your dog will be crated until you arrive. If you have not called by 6 PM to make arrangements for transportation you will be charged an additional overnight fee of \$70 if the facility closes before you arrive. Emergency bath or flea dip, tick removal will be billed at grooming rate.

Get Started

- 1. Return the following forms, along with your non-refundable, non-transferable, \$20 processing fee
- Understand your risk, sign & return page 4
- Your application, return page 5
- Our liability waiver, sign & return page 6
- 2. Provide vaccine & health history: see Daycare Requirements 1-3 (including flea protection, spay or neuter)
- 3. Schedule your interview
- 4. Show proof of current town dog license at interview
- 5. Be approved by our trainer

*Remember to pre-pay and reserve your specific dates each month in advance to avoid taking a chance that your day becomes fully booked. Drop Ins that have not pre-paid must call that morning to confirm availability before arriving.



Pet Degree Dog Training Center, LLC Doggie Daycare Requirements

Dogs may be put on "probation" and will be given the opportunity to correct the undesirable behavior then given a second chance before dismissal. Grounds for dismissal are (but are not limited to) excessive barking, not housebroken, marking, destructive, bullying, touch sensitive, unresponsive to corrections, unfriendly with strangers, late pick ups or late payments.

All dogs interested in enrolling for daycare will have an interview and evaluation process to meet our socialization and temperament requirements. Dogs over 6 months of age must be spayed or neutered. Vaccination records will be checked. We offer the opportunity for you to check out our facility and give us a chance to meet your dog by appointment only. We ask that you do not drop by during regular daycare hours without a confirmed appointment. Please be sure to schedule with us prior to your arrival to ensure that you will have our personal attention at that time.

Submit a copy of your dog's vaccination records along with this application. Please be sure that they are not reminders that your dog is due to be vaccinated but **actual dates of the last vaccinations.** You will be asked to update your records with us every 6 months. Your vet may fax them to us in advance if you prefer.

Vaccine Checklist

Rabies Certificate

DHLPP (distemper combo)

Bordetella (kennel cough)

Negative fecal testing within last 30 days

Proof of flea and tick prevention (no flea collars)

Proof of Heartgard protection for heartworm,

roundworm, and hookworm year round

Proof of spay or neuter (over 6 months)

Proof of current town license (over 6 months)

Please ensure your dog is housebroken, not toy or food protective, and has a quick release snap collar prior to your interview.

We do not separate by size or breed specifically, only by play styles and our requirements are that your dog must be compatible with our play group. We reserve the right to refuse admittance at the trainer's discretion. We ask that you do not bring any food, favorite toys or bedding that may be ruined or have possession issues. Please advise us of any food allergies in your application.

If an issue arises while in our care, you will be contacted by the information you provide us with. Please keep this information accurate and up to date! If your regular vet is unavailable or not in our area, we will contact that office first and have them speak with the emergency vet whenever possible.

Please do not bring your dog to daycare if your dog has any of these symptoms

Coughing Runny nose or runny eyes Diarrhea

Vomiting Lethargic behavior Excessive sneezing

If we notice any of these symptoms you will be required to pick up your pet immediately. We do not have the ability to quarantine your pet and do not wish to put others at risk. Please respect that it is for everyone's protection.

*Be sure to allow enough time in the morning for your dog to eliminate before dropping off. Don't risk dismissal just because you are in a hurry.

Accidents & Injuries

While our staff will do everything possible to avoid problems, daycare is not without risk. When dogs play together things can get rough even though no aggression is involved. It is not unlikely that your dog could experience an injury such as the following as a result of being here: minor cuts, scrapes or teeth marks, tooth loss, injured legs, tendons, joints, torn or detached toe nails etc. We offer a secure environment with dog specific Tenderfoot flooring to minimize your risk. You will be required to sign a waiver that you accept the possibility of injury to your dog and allow us to seek emergency treatment when necessary.

Health

Dogs are required to have flea prevention medication, however, as you know, fleas, and also viruses are not always so obvious. It is possible that your dog could pick up fleas, other parasites, or viruses while playing with other dogs in daycare. The staff will be diligent about notifying you of any health related concerns among the dogs in daycare. You will agree to act responsibly when bringing your dog to daycare where health issues are concerned and will not hold us responsible should your dog's health be compromised by something out of our control. You have reviewed and fully understand all the Doggie Daycare requirements and the How It Works policy.

You are agreeing to abide by these rules including health, fees, hours, reservations, and understand the potential grounds for dismissal. The representation of your dog on the application and at the interview has been truthful.

We have made you aware and have discussed your concerns. By signing, you have indicated that you believe that Pet Degree Dog Training Center's policies and it's associates are competent enough to entrust your dog to and are not held responsible.

Pet Degree reserves the right to refuse any services for any dog at any time for any reason. It is Pet Degrees intention that your dog be handled with the greatest of care. As a dog owner you understand the risks involved. The unpredictable personality of dogs can sometimes lead to injury. The liability of any circumstance related to your dog will not exceed the current chattel value of a dog of the same breed as the one in our care. By signing this agreement, you acknowledge and understand the risk the unexpected situations may arise during your absense or a stress related condition upon your return.
